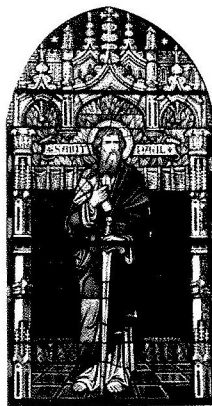


Year of Saint Paul



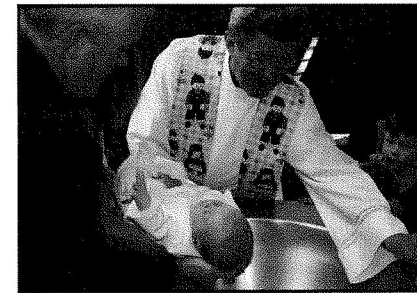
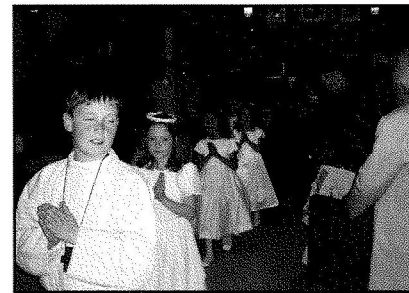
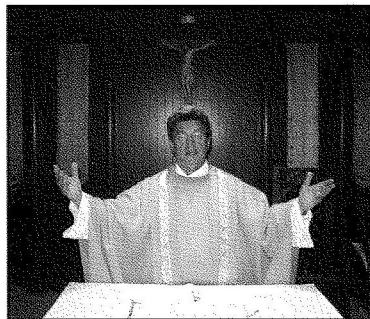
My Dear Parishioners,

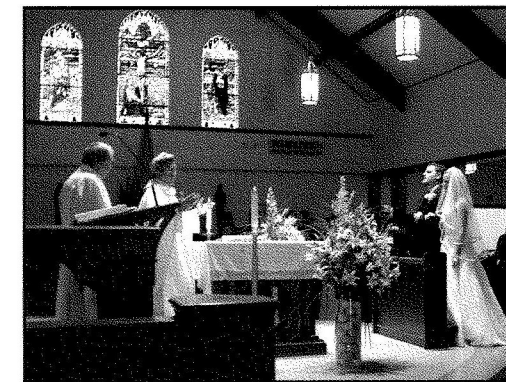
