GOOD FRIDAY WALK

For 30 years the Good Friday Walk has assisted needy persons on the North Shore area with funds for housing, utility bills, food, clothing, and other essentials of life. During that time, the Good Friday Walk has distributed more than **two million dollars** to North Shore families in need. Shelters, soup kitchens, Third-World self-help projects and missionaries have also benefited from funds raised. It could not be done without the many dedicated walkers who continue to support this cause.

The 31st Annual Good Friday Walk will take place on **Friday, April 2**, rain or shine. The Walk begins and ends at St. John the Evangelist School on Cabot Street in Beverly. It follows a scenic 11 mile route through downtown Beverly, the Beverly Cove, and Beverly Farms with rest stops at churches along the way. Last year more than 500 walkers participated and raised close to \$35,000. The goal for this year is to increase the number of walkers by 100.

Due to the high unemployment rate and the current economic climate, The Good Friday Walk is getting calls requesting assistance from more people than ever who find themselves unable to make ends meet. You can help by collecting donations from friends and relatives and walking or by sponsoring someone else's walk. Walkers who collect \$20.00 or more will receive a commemorative T-shirt.

The Walk route and sponsor sheets can be downloaded from the Good Friday Walk website, www.goodfridaywalk.org. **Sponsor sheets are also available at the entrances of the church.**

Walk registration begins on Good Friday at 7:30 am and ends at 9:30 am. All walkers will return to St. John's School no later than 3:00 pm.
